



Deck 6 - E Deck

- Cabin has one additional bed in the form of a single sofa bed
 - Cabin has two additional beds in the form of a double sofa bed
- ♦ Cabin has two additional beds in the form of pull-down beds
- Fixed double bedCabin has a chair instead of a sofa • Cabins with interconnecting doors
- Steel fronted balcony
- Cabins with shower only
- View over decks rather than sea view
- Balcony visible from above and/or neighbouring balconies
- Balcony is partially shaded
 All adapted cabins have a shower only

Note: all pull-down beds in twin cabins are accessible via a ladder. When pull-down beds are in use, lower beds cannot be converted to a double. Balconies in the forward section of the ship can be overlooked by the bridge.
